


How to Permanently Redirect your Feedburner Feed

NOTE: Please read through the tutorial TWICE before attempting to follow the directions. Failure to follow instructions exactly can result in bad bad things.


Step 1 - go to feedburner.com (login if needed)

Step 2 - click on your feed you want to delete / redirect

Step 3 - click on “Edit Feed Details”

Step 4 - Make sure the “Original Feed” is the feed you want to redirect to.

You should not change "Original Feed" unless you move your original feed to a new domain or a new location on your existing server. Also, changing "Feed Address" will require you to update your feed subscribers with your new address; the previous feed address will no longer work.

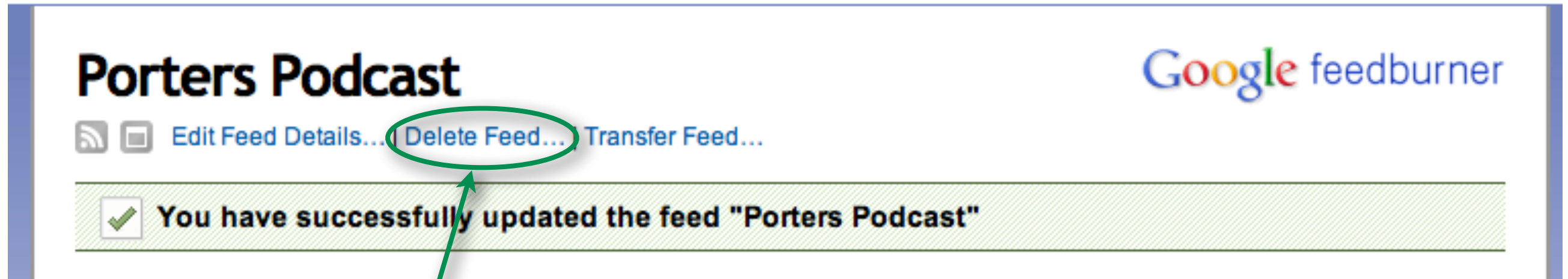

Step 5 - Click “Save Feed Details”

You should then see the message “you have successfully updated the feed...”



Step 6 - Click “Delete Feed...”

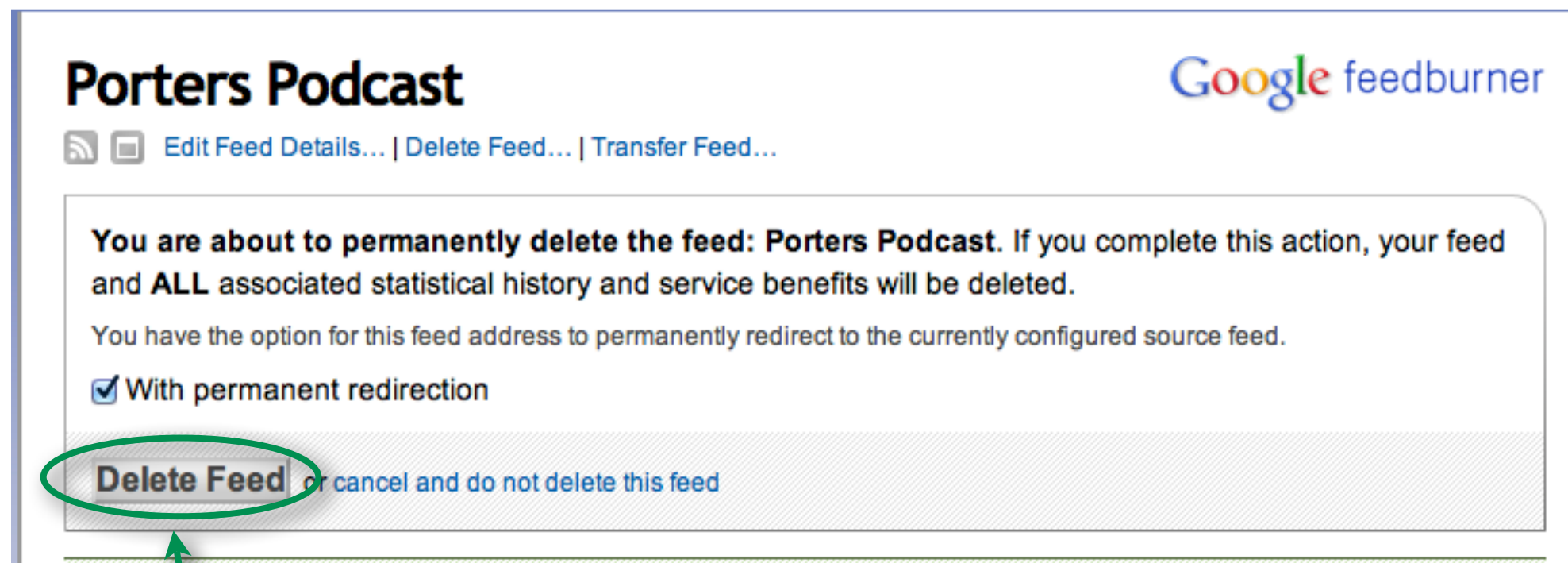

Step 7 - Click the check box next to “With Permanent Redirection” first.



Step 8 - Once you see the check box selected - you can then click on the “Delete Feed” button.

If you click the “Delete Feed” button with out the permanent redirection button selected you will loose your feed and NOT have a redirect. That is a Bad thing!!!!

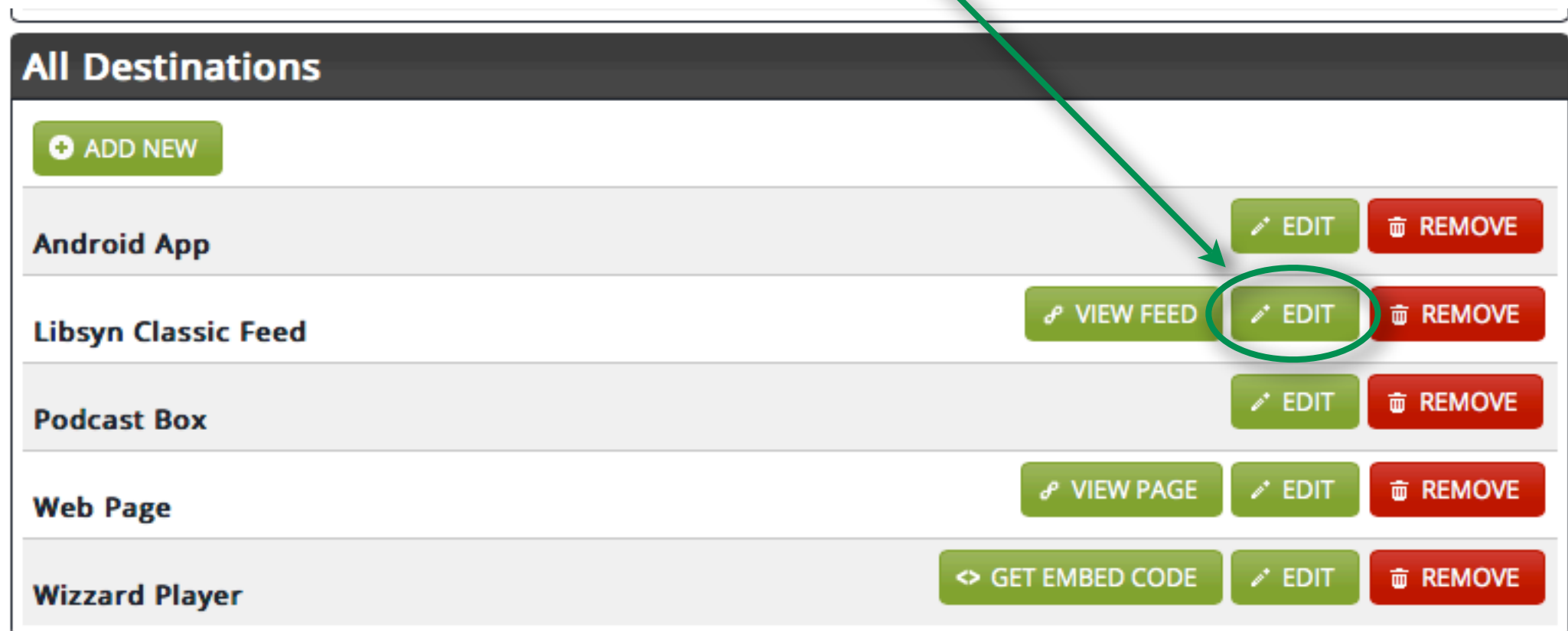

If all was done correctly you will see something similar to the above - where if you click on “View this Feed” it will take you to the URL you are now redirecting to.

Step 9 - Setting up the iTunes New Feed Tag in your libsyn Account - Optional - but recommended if your source feed is the libsyn Feed. In your libsyn UI - select Destinations - and then click on “Edit” for your “Libsyn Feed”



Step 10 - Scroll down to “Advanced Options” and then in the Extra RSS Tags - add in your iTunes new feed tag:

Step 11 - Click “Save”

At this point your Feedburner redirect is in place and pointing to your original source URL - which is a feed you have control of.

If your source feed is a libsyn feed and you added in the iTunes new feed tag - then going forward all those subscribed with iTunes and the Podcasts app will be just subscribed to your libsyn feed - and no matter what happens at google/feedburner - your subscribers are safe and under your control in your libsyn account.
